The Director will:

- Provide overall supervision and leadership for the Economic Development department, which includes leading staff and liaising with the Mayor and Council.
- Design programs and strategies to attract new commercial, industrial, and residential development.
- Establish, foster and maintain positive relationships within the community, the local business community, and with other levels of government and stakeholders.
- Maintain current economic development information from regional, provincial, national and international sources.
- Respond to information requests from the general public and business community.
- Act as a liaison to the Alberta Industrial Heartland Association and other Economic Development associations.
- Provide advice and support to internal clients and works closely with the Planning & Development, Marketing and Communications departments.

A knowledge of municipal government and a good understanding of property development are key components. This position requires post-secondary education (degree program) in Economic Development and/or Commerce, along with a minimum of six years related experience.
