Parkland County has a Permanent, Full-time position available in the Engineering Services Department for a Senior Project Engineer. Reporting to the Manager, Engineering Projects, this position provides support by assuming project management responsibilities on Capital projects within Engineering Services. Projects will focus on development or major rehabilitation of municipal service areas including, but not limited to, transportation, water, sanitary, storm water, and utility infrastructure. This position needs to be well organized and have the ability to manage multiple ongoing activities at various stages of completion. Strong interpersonal and communication skills are necessary. This position will liaise with persons throughout the County at all levels and must be able to effectively work alone and within a team environment. This position may supervise up to one individual directly but will indirectly lead small working groups in a team environment.
