As the Transit Planner II, you will be providing technical support and participate in various projects and initiatives related to transit service delivery, performance monitoring, long range planning, and infrastructure requirements. Some of the key responsibilities include:

- Define problems related to the provision of transit service and recommend solutions to these problems.
- Write performance reports that meet ETS requirements.
- Analyze the operational performance of existing transit services and schedules, and develop operational plans for transit services
 designed to accommodate existing and projected travel demand.
- Prepare Annual, Five Year and Long range Transit Service Plans, including the development of methodology and technical processes required to support this work.
- Respond to service related inquiries and participate in public outreach activities.
- Prepare and participate in route testing to determine route travel times, and resolve operational issues for new routes and route
 modifications.
- Provide technical support for Route Management Process.
- Serve as a resource for multi-disciplinary studies addressing operational, technical, and policy function of Edmonton Transit.
- Review design plans of proposed roadways, neighbourhoods and transit centres, and provide recommendations where required
- Perform analysis towards the completion of the Annual Operating Budget.
- Participate in studies related to transit system improvements in Edmonton, including Light Rail Transit expansion.

- Bachelor degree in Urban Planning or a degree related to the functions specific to the position (Engineering) supplemented by course
 work in Transportation Planning or Civil Engineering
- Minimum of four (4) years direct experience in the urban transportation planning field
- Experience in developing and implementing Service Plans and Operating Budgets
