DEPUTY FIRE CHIEF

The Town of Okotoks Fire Services is committed to supporting and working in a progressive fire and emergency service environment. The Town is seeking a Deputy Fire Chief who will work with our other Deputy and exercise considerable initiative and judgment in ensuring overall operational programs are conducted in accordance with Town of Okotoks and Fire Services. Both Deputies provide leadership at on-site emergency situations & quality coaching and leadership to firefighters. In addition to Deputy duties, the specific focus of this position is training for Fire Services in its entirety, and coordination of Volunteer Firefighters. This position works five 8 hour shifts, and participates regularly in on-call rotation.

Minimum requirements are high school diploma plus 8 years experience in progressively responsible emergency service positions, supplemented by formal training in leadership, Incident Command, Human Relations, and management administration. Post-secondary education in these areas is a definite asset, as well as experience in public speaking. Extensive knowledge of the Alberta Fire Code, Building Code and be a Safety Codes Officer (Fire) holding the minimum level of Inspector I, Investigator I will contribute to your success in this position. The successful candidate must be a minimum Emergency Medical Responder. Physical assessment is required.
