Reporting to the Supervisor, Parks & Open Spaces, this position performs all aspects of work related to the day to day operations of parks and facilities including winter and summer maintenance of parks, pool, outdoor ice rinks and other Town owned facilities.

## **Qualifications:**

- Requires successful completion of Grade 12 high school or equivalent.
- Requires at least 2 years' experience in a similar position.
- Must have a Class G driver's license in good standing with a minimum of one year of experience in the operation of all Parks related equipment/machinery.
- Must have the ability to perform basic mathematical calculations, legible handwriting and ability to communicate with the public and other staff in a polite and diplomatic manner.
- Ability to perform a variety of semi-skilled and skilled turf maintenance duties in order to develop, maintain and repair playing fields.
- Ability to operate and maintain safely and efficiently truck and trailer combinations, front end loaders, tractors and tractor driven equipment including gang mowers, chainsaws, hand and power tools and other park maintenance equipment
- Must be familiar with the Occupational Health and Safety Act and the duties of a Worker under the act.
- Must provide clean vulnerable sector check

## **Responsibilities:**

- Maintains the parks and outdoor facilities of the Town as set out by the New Tecumseth Parks Maintenance Standards including but not limited to the following: inspects and maintains ball diamonds and soccer fields ensuring that playing surfaces and warning tracks are maintained to established standards, trims trees and branches as required to keep all grounds in safe and orderly conditions, repairs, paints and generally keeps in good working repair, all park equipment such as entrance gates, goal posts, bleachers, fences, etc., lays sod, ensures that garbage is picked up daily from parks facilities, inspects, repairs and maintains logs on playground equipment, recognizes and eliminates hazardous conditions.
- Performs maintenance checks, oil changes and minor tune-ups on any mobile equipment. Keeps all equipment clean and in good working order. Performs circle checks before using equipment.
- Maintains swimming pool and pool area during the summer season

The successful candidate must have the ability to align with established goals and objectives and is able to create/follow plans and processes accordingly to deliver task and goal completion to a high standard. The Town of New Tecumseth values progressive ideas and actions;- the successful candidate will have proven ability to embrace change, be resourceful and to seek new ideas and creativity to maximize effectiveness to provide high quality citizen-centred services to our community.
