Thorough knowledge of modern firefighting techniques and the rules, regulations and policies that govern the activities of a Fire Department including Fire Codes and Bylaws is essential.

You have a demonstrated track record in fire services management and incident command including a minimum of fifteen (15) years of progressive experience in the Fire Service supplemented with post-secondary education, certificate or diploma level, from a recognized education institution in any one of the following disciplines; civic management, fire executive management, business administration, emergency management, human resources management, Fire Officer Level 4, and/or an equivalent combination of practical and demonstrated experience.
