This position will also direct Emergency Management activities, reporting to Council and handling media inquiries and dealing with government agencies relating to Fire Services and Emergency Management.

Advanced public relations and written & oral communication skills are a strong asset. Strong organizational skills, analytical and technical aptitude is required. The successful candidate must maintain "verifiable reliability" security clearance.
