EQUIPMENT OPERATOR II (GRADER OPERATOR)

(Seasonal)

Parkland County has a Seasonal position available in Road Maintenance & Drainage for an Equipment Operator II working six months out of the year. Stationed in Stony Plain and reporting to the Foreman, the primary duty will be to operate a motor grader maintaining roads in an assigned beat area and occasionally elsewhere throughout the County. The grader is normally parked within the beat area at an assigned site and the Operator is required to report to work at that site. The Operator will be placed on stand-by when there is no work available. Duties also include operation of other road maintenance equipment and manual labour as required. The ability to effectively coordinate work to accomplish objectives in an efficient manner; keep accurate, detailed and legible records; deal effectively with the public and other staff members and work independently are required.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Five (5) years' experience working with road maintenance equipment in a rural municipal setting with a minimum of two (2) years' experience operating a motor grader in the maintenance of gravel roads.
 Experience to include both summer and winter maintenance.
- Experience with road gravelling procedures, road shoulder pulling and road maintenance procedures is required. Working on dust controls and oil surfaced roads and patching oil type or cold mix surfaces is an asset.
- Valid Alberta Class 3 Operators License with Q (air) endorsement. Upon hire, a current commercial driver's abstract must be provided.
