To conduct field surveys, collect data, edit, process, prepare engineering and legal survey plans and documents using GPS, electronic surveying instruments and automated data collection technology, CAD (Computer Aided Design) and GIS (Geographic Information Systems). Perform data processing, analysis, integration and complex mathematical calculations using surveys applications and programs. Undertake internal record searches, title searches and prepare compiled plans and sketches to clearly identify ownership / titles of land and other inquiries. Perform records management duties to update and maintain database catalogues, data sets and disseminate information. Research, investigate and recommend new technology, processes and procedures for

surveys and mapping operations. Provide technical expertise, training support for Surveys and Mapping functions to Regional staff, ABC's and consultants.
