- Ontario College of Trades Qualification as an Automotive Service Technician (310S) may be considered an asset.

- Completion of a Truck and Coach Technician (310T) apprenticeship as per Ontario College of Trades Qualification.
- Minimum 5 years working experience as a journeyman.
