The hours of work at the facility are 6:30am-3:00pm, Monday to Friday.

You are a safety conscious, hardworking, team player looking for the chance to use your electrical skills and knowledge in a variety of applications. You are able to work independently without close, direct supervision and are physically able to perform industrial electrical work.

This role: *(The duties described hereunder are intended to be representative of the position and are not to be considered as all inclusive.)*

- Install, test, trouble shoot and maintain electrical systems and equipment throughout MVRD facilities, ie: fabrication, wiring and installation of control systems, solid state, motors, lighting, low, medium and high voltage power equipment, etc.
- Plans own work approach, searches for and purchases most materials.
- Prepares sketches and updates drawings and prints.
- Assists superior with cost estimating and scheduling work.
- Submits work progress reports.
- Assists in the training of apprentices.

To be successful, you have:

- Grade 12, plus BC (or Interprovincial) Trade Qualification Certificate as a, journeyman Electrician.
- Valid BC driver's license and health certificate for watershed entry.
- Basic knowledge of motors, controls, pneumatics, electronics, solid state (hydraulics) controls, computer interface, draughting.
- Provide own hand tools.
