POSITION OVERVIEW

This is front-line recreation work performed in support of Children's programs. An incumbent participates in leadership and instruction of programs, special events, camps and outdoor activities for children. The work is performed under close supervision and according to specific instructions. The incumbent is expected to exercise tact and diplomacy in public contact but difficult and unusual situations are referred to a superior who reviews work for effectiveness and compliance with policies and procedures.
