The District of Saanich is seeking an experienced operational Manager to lead its Fleet Service Section. Fleet is responsible for all aspects of fleet services and the operation of the Municipal Fleet Centre. The successful candidate will manage a multi-trade workforce engaged in maintenance and repair of municipal assets, repair services and will participate in the procurement of municipal assets.

As a leader in corporate sustainability, the Manager is responsible for developing, implementing, and monitoring innovative and cost-effective fleet operation strategies that meet corporate sustainability goals. This includes reducing corporate greenhouse gas emissions an advanced sustainable fleet maintenance management system and industry best practice.

The successful candidate will have thorough knowledge of principles, methods, equipment and tools of the automotive mechanical trade, particularly as related to the overhaul and repair of a mixed municipal fleet.

They will be an innovator with a commitment to lifelong learning, organizational excellence, and knowledge development and have demonstrated ability to lead and supervise employees in a unionized environment. They will be a critical thinker with superior interpersonal, written and verbal skills including public speaking and presentation skills.
