Bordered by rugged mountains and situated on a peninsula (no, it's not an Island) in the traditional territory of the shishalh and Skwxwú7mesh First Nations, this area is known for its mild winters, beautiful surroundings, arts, recreation, and culture, and it is a preferred tourist destination and a great place to live, work and play. You can hike, bike, camp, kayak, golf, do fiber arts, snowshoe, fish, scuba dive, walk the scenic trails in the amazing parks, windsurf or, as was portrayed in the former TV show on CBC, you could even get into some beachcombing here on the beautiful Sunshine Coast.

The Sunshine Coast Regional District is currently inviting applications for the position of Site Attendant (Casual). We are looking for two friendly, capable people to add to the Solid Waste team! The Site Attendant works under the direct or indirect supervision of the Superintendent Solid Waste Operations and may receive work direction from the Site Supervisor when working at the Sechelt site. This position monitors waste being delivered to the working face and other designated management areas of the landfill site by waste haulers and the public. Acts as relief Scale Attendant as needed to ensure the safe, efficient and effective operation of the landfill site. Ensures delivery of service meets the expectations of internal and external customers and is in accordance with the appropriate regulatory requirements.

This is a bargaining unit position with a wage rate of **\$28.18 per hour**. Casual workers receive an additional 4% vacation pay and 5% statutory holiday pay. For the balance of 2022, there is a small additional increase to 5.38% based on a temporary statutory holiday.

## **Please note:**

- > Incumbents must be available to work at both the Sechelt and Pender Harbour sites.
- Casual work is short notice relief work, 7 days a week, relieving employees who are on sick leave, leave of absence, vacation, or peak work periods for overload situations.
- > There are no regularly scheduled hours nor any guarantee of hours.
