Under the general direction of the Fire Chief (GDVFD), the FireSmart Coordinator is responsible for the facilitation of FireSmart-related activities within the Sunshine Coast Regional District. The position will ensure that the FireSmart activities are supported, developed, and implemented in accordance with Provincial guidelines as well as with the direction and policy provided by the Sunshine Coast Regional District.

This full-time exempt position includes an annual salary ranging from \$78,412 up to a merit maximum of \$99,583. This position includes vacation that starts at 4 full weeks, and a full benefits package that commences upon employment. Benefits include extended health and dental coverage, paid sick leave, family responsibility leave, short-term disability, group life insurance, eyewear, eye exams, long term disability benefits and accidental death and dismemberment coverage. We are currently operating in a hybrid work environment with flexible work schedules based upon a 35-hour week, all by mutual agreement.
