- Training in ASQ, Triple P, Circle of Security, and Nobody's Perfect would be considered an asset.
- Experience in Emergency Social Services is an asset.
- Be willing to work flexible hours that may include evenings and weekends.
- Must have an operator's license and vehicle to drive.
