MYzone and MYgame run at various locations throughout the city.

Responsibilities

Duties include (but are not limited to):

- Ensuring developmentally appropriate activities are planned and implemented.
- Regular communication with supervisors, program assistants and parents.
- Ensuring children are safe and engaged.
- Ensuring space is safe and supplies are adequate.
- Confirming all program forms are filled completely and correctly.
- Attending scheduled team meetings and mandatory trainings.

The successful applicant will have experience in lesson planning as well as good communication and organizational skills. They will also have sound knowledge of developmental assets for children and guiding children's behaviour.

Qualifications

- Completion of Grade 12 supplemented by some post-secondary education from a recognized institution.
- Current First Aid and CPR-C Certification.
- Experience as an instructor with school aged children.
- 2 years related work experience or equivalent.
- High Five Certification (or willingness to acquire).
- Food Safe Certification (or willingness to acquire).

Applicants under consideration will be required to provide proof of qualifications and consent to a Police Information Check/Vulnerable Sector Check.
