Bordered by rugged mountains and blue ocean waters, situated on a peninsula (not an island) in the traditional lands of the shíshálh and Skwxwú7mesh First Nations, this area is known for its mild winters, beautiful surroundings, arts, and culture. With all the amazing recreation at our doorstep, it is not just a preferred tourist destination, it is also a great place to live, work, and play.

Position Overview

The Sunshine Coast Regional District is currently inviting applications for the position of casual Arena Worker. We are looking for a friendly and service-oriented person to join our team! Working within a community development philosophy and reporting to the Facility & Program Coordinator, Arena & Sports, this position greets and answers inquiries from the public and patrons of the Sechelt and Gibsons' ice arenas; provides skate shop and skate patrol services, performs cash handling and janitorial duties.

Compensation and Hours of Work

This is a bargaining unit position with a wage rate of **\$22.91 per hour** supplemented by an additional 4% vacation pay and then 5% statutory holiday pay after 30 days of employment. After 90 days of employment, casual workers are eligible for up to 5 paid sick days for scheduled work and will then receive 6% vacation pay after successfully passing a 4-month probationary period. Casual workers are also eligible to join the General Casual List for potential work opportunities elsewhere within the SCRD.

Please note:

Incumbents must be available on weekdays and weekends, noting that early mornings and late evenings may be required. Casual work is short notice relief work, 7 days a week, relieving employees who are on sick leave, leave of absence, vacation, or peak work periods for overload situations. There are no regularly scheduled hours nor any guarantee of hours. **Appointment is subject to a satisfactory RCMP Criminal Records Check.**
