The successful candidate must have the following qualifications:

1. Completion of a university degree in Urban Planning or a related discipline, such as geography, sociology, urban development, sustainable development, etc.
2. Membership in good standing with the Canadian Institute of Planners and a minimum of three years' experience as a planner in a municipal or private sector environment, including previous experience in both a technical and analytical planning role
OR
Completion of a Master's degree in urban planning or a related discipline and the ability to acquire full membership with the Canadian Institute of Planners within two years of employment and a minimum five years' experience in a municipal or private sector environment, including previous experience in both a technical and analytical planning role.
3. Minimum of one-year previous leadership experience.
4. Valid BC Driver's Licence - Class 5 or equivalent.
