Equipment Operator

Reporting to the Supervisor of Public Works, the Equipment Operator is required to operate and perform minor maintenance of mobile construction and maintenance equipment, including, but not limited to backhoe, front end loaders with bucket, blade and wing, snow blowers, roller, street sweeper, skid loader.

Duties will include:

- Required to perform manual task (specialized or otherwise) or drive a truck when not operating.
- Required to perform any other duties as may be assigned by the Operations Supervisor or designate.
- Required to take a regular turn on call.
