- Preparing an inventory of Delta's seawalls;
- Preparing a master cost estimate spreadsheet for municipal infrastructure;
- Assisting with reviewing development-related drawings, reports, and analyses and providing feedback to your superior; and
- Performing a variety of inspections and tasks when needed.
