OPERATIONS WORKER III - CONCRETE Permanent Full Time

Come join our team for an exciting career in local government. Saanich Street Operations is seeking an Operations Worker III. The Operations Worker III will be responsible for: completing a variety of road maintenance and construction tasks in the maintenance and repair of municipal street infrastructure with a focus on our concrete assets; technical and manual work involving the coordination and leadership of a crew of workers and equipment operators; the delivery of capital works projects and maintenance activities as it relates to concrete assets; ensure that concrete finishing equipment is maintained and in good working condition; responding to and investigating complaints from the public and initiating corrective action for sidewalk trip hazards, concrete barriers and other related assets; may be required to respond to emergency and storm events as they arise.

Requirements include Grade 12 or equivalent; three years' experience in Roads Construction and/or Maintenance with a focus on coordinating the forming, placing, and finishing of concrete assets. Experience with steel curb/gutter & sidewalk forms and monolithic and separated concrete pours; a valid B.C. Class 3 BC Driver's Licence with an air brake endorsement; Occupational First Aid Level I Certificate; Traffic Control Person Certificate; (Training will be provided in Municipal Pavement Maintenance Certification and Certification in Snow and Ice Control); and sufficient health, physical conditioning, strength, stamina and coordination to permit performance of heavy manual work in all weather conditions. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.

The successful candidate will work Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. (40 hours per week).
