You will also be required to perform a variety of labour related duties as part of the drainage crew.

The ideal candidate would have the following:

- Experience operating a variety of medium to heavy duty equipment used in road/drainage maintenance and construction with emphasis on excavator and crawler tractor operation.
- Knowledge in the use of various types of grade stakes.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills and the ability to deal effectively with the public.
- Valid Class 3 Driver's License with Q endorsement or the ability to acquire within 60 days of hiring.
- Alberta Class 1 Driver's License with Q endorsement would be an asset.
