EMPLOYMENT STATUS

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Installing mains, service connections and related components associated to water, sanitary, and drainage systems.
- Assembling pipes and ensuring that tees, bends, crosses, valves and related fittings are properly installed.
- Installing water services using open trench, trenchless methods or combination of both.
- Operating (open/close/flush/repair) water valves on water mains, service connections and appurtenances.
- Constructing, placing, setting forms and finishing associated to concrete blocks, headwalls, manholes, retaining walls, sidewalk panels, pavers, pavement, curb, gutters and related concrete structures.
- · Measuring, cutting and setting forms and establishing lines and grades.
- · Ordering supplies and materials as needed.
- Assisting crew members in performing their duties.
- Using a variety of hand and power tools.
- Other job-related duties as assigned.
