Along with a bachelor's degree, you have a minimum of one year of related experience in an economic development, housing development or planning role. With a diploma, you have a minimum of three years of related experience. The position will require a combination of strong interpersonal and communication skills and a solid understanding of the housing development process. A valid class 5 driver's license is required.
