As a Facility Operator III at the FVRD, you will be responsible for assisting with facility operation and maintenance of our Recreation Centre. In this position, the successful candidate must be available for shifts within the 24-hour operation of the facility including evenings, weekends, and some holidays. A typical week could see you performing regular plant and facility checks; operating the refrigeration and ice-making equipment; helping maintain the cleanliness of the facility by performing janitorial duties; enforcing the rules and regulations of the facility during public events; and providing assistance to the public and the user groups that use the recreation complex.

We offer a positive, supportive, team-based work environment with an emphasis on collaboration. If you have a positive, can-do attitude and a keen sense of humour, you will fit right in.

The ideal candidate must have:

- » BC Safety Authority Fifth Class Power Engineer Certificate (refrigeration);
- » A minimum of three years experience in a maintenance/janitorial environment, preferably in a recreation or educational facility;
- » BCRPA Pool Operator's Certificate (Level II), or be willing and able to obtain this certificate;
- » RFABC Ice Maker's Training Course Certificate, or be willing and able to obtain this certificate;
- » Basic knowledge of conditions, water filters, refrigeration, and other mechanical equipment and machinery;
- » Ability to operate ice resurface machine, ice edger, and other related arena and pool equipment;
- » Good customer service skills, courtesy, tact, and diplomacy and the ability to remain professional when dealing with the public;
- » Good written and verbal communication skills, with the ability to communicate clearly and effectively;
- » Able to pass a Criminal Record Check
- » A valid Driver's Licence.

The rate for this casual union position is \$34.56 per hour plus 14% in lieu of benefits. This casual position is to relieve or replace employees on an intermittent and temporary basis.
