Requirements include: one year of post-secondary education; enrollment in a full-time post-secondary education program is mandatory; preference will be given to those enrolled in a parks-related field such as Geography, Resource Management, or Outdoor Recreation, etc. at a University or Technical Institution; one month previous work experience; and a valid Class 5 B.C. Driver's Licence is preferred. Candidates with an equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.

The successful candidate will work a 35-hour week, generally Monday to Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. with occasional evening or weekend work depending on operational needs.
