RESPONSIBILITIES

- Locate various valves and hydrants using a water map book, and construction drawings.
- Repair damaged or faulty hydrants.
- Inspects and maintains valves and hydrants by following a standard operating procedure for hydrant maintenance (AWWA). Records information on hydrants.
- Clean out debris and brush around fire hydrants.
- Use a variety of hand and power tools.
- Assign and oversees the work of others.
- Assist crew members in performing their duties.
- Keep an inventory of and orders hydrant parts and components.
- Respond to inquiries from the public.
- Provide field services for Hydrant Use Permits.
