Key Responsibilities

- Clean, lubricate and perform other routine maintenance work on vehicles and equipment

- Completion of service reports and records of maintenance for each unit or vehicle.

- Must provide your own shop tools.
- The ability to obtain an Alberta Commercial Vehicle Inspection Program license.
- Valid Class 5 required, Alberta Operators License; Class 1 and/or 3 or Q, considered an asset.
- Able to effectively meet physical demands with this position.
- Moderate to heavy physical fitness level of activity, including to be able to lift/carry more than 25 kg on occasion.
- Fleet maintenance background would be an asset.
- Demonstrates good prioritization and problem-solving skills.
- Ability to work on multiple projects.
- Demonstrated safe working skills and a proven record of safe work practices.

- Must be willing to work outside in all conditions, including in challenging environments.
