This position also supports the purchasing and disposal of fleet assets and monitors the equipment pool operating budget.

- Post Secondary Education or Trade Certificate in a related discipline.
- Professional experience directly related to maintenance and repairs of light duty and heavy-duty road construction and maintenance equipment, including welding repairs and processes as well as preventative and scheduled maintenance.
- The proven ability to communicate effectively in a maintenance and repair setting with strong customer service and interpersonal skills.
- Supervision or mentorship experience of vehicle/equipment maintenance and repair staff.
