EDUCATION:

OTHER:

- Must have and maintain a valid NB Class 1 or 2 license with a minimum of seven (7) years driving experience or a valid NB Class 5 license with a minimum of seven (7) years driving experience.
- A clean driving abstract is required.

- Independent study
- Medical
- Written/Vision test
- Air Brake test
- Three-week training period in preparation for road test on top of regular transit training.
