

## **Senior Engineering Technologist (Development)**

We are looking for a motivated professional to support the operations of the Development division.

Reporting to the Manager of Development Engineering, this position will oversee development construction activated and site alteration works.

## **Duties and responsibilities:**

- Manages project files, coordinates preconstruction meetings and monthly development meetings and acts as the contact person for the development community related to administrative matters for construction.
- Attends site meetings on behalf of the Development Division and provides direction to developers and consultants on in field matters arising from the meetings.
- Monitors activities relating to fill, site alteration, drainage and grading complaints.
- Work closely with Development Engineering staff, other service areas and the Town's engineering consultants to ensure compliance with the Towns' Design Criteria Manual and other design guidance documents and industry standards.
- Reviews and makes recommendations to the Manager on the appropriateness of security reduction requests from developers. Prepares the tracking documents, reduction requests and support documents for approval by the manager.
- Prepare reports and provide assistance to the Manager, Development Engineering in the preparation of development agreements, requests for proposals and other legal engineering documents.
- Assist the service area in addressing resident/community group issues.

## **Key Competencies and Qualifications:**

- Diploma in Civil Engineering Technology or related.
- Preference given to those eligible for the CET designation.
- Minimum of five years' experience, preferably in municipal services engineering.
- Working knowledge of Ontario Provincial Standards Specifications; Ontario Provincial Standard Drawings; ASTM, AWWA, CSA; Ministry of Transportation Design Manuals / Construction Manual; Ontario Traffic Manual and the OHSA.
- Advanced knowledge of construction practices and methods, including the ability to interpret
  engineering drawings and documents.
- Excellent interpersonal, project/time/records management, organizational, analytical, research, communication, presentation and problem-solving skills.
- Demonstrated proficiency with information technology including GIS and Bluebeam.
- A valid Ontario class G driver's license in good standing.
- Ability to provide a satisfactory Criminal Record and Judicial Matters Check upon hire.

The position offers a salary range of \$83,328 to \$104,160 (2024 rates) based on a 40 hour work week, plus a competitive benefit package and the option for flexible work arrangements.
