The Opportunity

Reporting directly to the Supervisor, Plans Examination/Deputy CBO, this role reviews and approves plans submitted for all Part 3 and Part 9 building permit applications, this includes all residential, commercial, and institutional buildings applications. As the Plans Examiner, Mechanical, you will perform the following duties, including but not limited to:

- Ensure all building permits they review and approve are in compliance with the Ontario Building Code
 (OBC) and all other applicable laws, standards and regulations. This review includes ensuring that they
 make any necessary notes or corrections on the approved building permit documents that form part of the
 issued building permit
- Plans Examiners are responsible to ensure that all their process reviews they have completed are correctly
 entered into the Towns permit administration database AMANDA. This electronic record is the Town's
 official record and ensuring clear and concise records are crucial in terms of data integrity.
- Communicate directly with the applicant and their design professionals both in writing and verbally with
 respect to plan review deficiencies they have identified and assist them with bringing their application into
 compliance with the OBC requirements. Along with assisting these clients this position is also responsible
 for responding to general inquiries from the public on OBC requirements and the permit process in general.
- Attend meetings_with clients to review potential proposals/applications including other internal
 Departmental staff and represent the Division in these meetings or attend along with their Supervisor or a
 Sr. Plans Examiner.
- Be able to work independly and as part of a larger team to achieve the overall objective of the Town and the Division – to ensure that all buildings built in the Town are safe for the building owners/occupants and members of the public by ensuring compliance with the Ontairo Building Code.
- Perform additional duties and undertake special projects as assigned



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The Ideal Candidate

We are seeking a professional with a minimum education, training and/or knowledge in the above, normally acquired from Post secondary degree/diploma or certificate in Architectural or Civil Engineering or closely related field. Our ideal candidate has a minimum of 3 years related experience in the construction industry or municipal government directly engaged in the building permit process, experience reading and interpreting plans, specifications and data sheets pertaining to architectural and structural design for compliance with the Ontario Building Code and other applicable standards and Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing qualifications in General Legal, Plumbing – House, and HVAC House.

Minimum 5 years related experience in the construction industry or as a plans examiner in a municipality is preferred. Must have a good understanding of the Ontario Building Code and Ontario Building Act.

The successful candidate for Plan Examiner, Mechanical will be required to work a flexible schedule, including in the office, remotely and after hours (as required).
