- Solid knowledge of electric power system operation and maintenance
- Proven ability to write professional reports
- Demonstrated ability to work on time-critical assignments under high pressure scenarios where quick decisions are required
- Competency in managing a project portfolio including a wide range of simple to complex projects
- Professionally sign and stamp engineering drawings
- Ability to analyze complex data, determine trends and make recommendations or propose further investigation.
- Ability to act as a responsible member under APEGA
- Required to travel outside of the City on an as needed basis for industry meetings
- Occasional exposure to electric hazards at transmission substations and/or construction sites
- Interruptions during evenings and weekends to respond to public or media on issues related to the Electric Utility.
