Scope

Responsibilities

As a Groundkeeper 2, you will be responsible for a variety of work that involves grounds maintenance and turf management and field inspections of work performed by contractors. Duties may include:

- Gardening
- Turf maintenance
- Litter control
- Training of seasonal staff
- Supervise a small work team
- Respond to inquiries from the public and community groups
- Assist in administering contracts for Parks division work
- Assist in preparing technical reports and maintain records

Qualifications

The successful candidate will meet one of the following criteria:

- Completed Grade 12, supplemented by the successful completion of five additional relevant courses from an approved post-secondary institution (horticulture, turf culture plant biology, arboriculture, landscape maintenance, landscape installation/design), plus 2 years recent experience in landscape maintenance/construction.
- Completion of Grade 12, supplemented by a Technical Certificate Program (one-year full-time) from an approved post-secondary institution, plus 18 months of recent experience in landscape maintenance/construction
- Completion of a diploma program from an approved post-secondary institution, plus a minimum of 6 months recent experience in landscape maintenance/construction.

You must also:

- Have a valid BC Driver's License with a safe driving record
- Pesticide Application's License – to be obtained before the completion of probation period.
- Be physically able to carry work of a heavy manual nature in all weather conditions.

Applicants under consideration will be required to consent to a Police Information Check/Vulnerable Sector Check
