This opportunity requires a background in the program area, either through continued professional development or through completion of accredited programs along with a background in program instruction. Duties will include developing curriculum upholding the high quality and professionalism in the City of New Westminster.

- Considerable knowledge of the principles, practices and objectives of programs in community recreation facilities.
- Sound knowledge of teaching methods and group leadership techniques.
- Excellent supervisory and organizational skills.
- Continued professional development or completion of an accredited program.
- Must be able to successfully pass and maintain a clear Police Information Check with Vulnerable Sector Check.
