Reporting to the Manager, IT Operations, in this unionized position you will provide network maintenance and support services to client departments.

## Responsibilities

- Install, upgrade and configure network hardware, including switches and firewalls
- Perform systems maintenance on core network infrastructure and ensure backup and recovery operations
- Monitor the performance and use of the network
- Prepare and maintain network documentation for systems operating procedures related to security and network applications structure
- Investigate, assess and resolve hardware and related software issues, including more complex user issues
- Perform related work as required

## Qualifications

- Completion of a two year diploma in computer technology from an institute of technology or community college plus sound related experience, or an equivalent combination of training and experience
- Considerable knowledge of the practices and procedures used in the identification and resolution of hardware and related software issues on networked computers
- Ability to install, test and upgrade and configure network hardware and related software
- Ability to prepare and maintain network documentation
- Working knowledge and hands on experience with Palo Alto Firewalls and Cisco Wired and Wireless technologies is considered an asset
