- Effectively and safely operates and/or assists with the operation of the equipment on any one of the above listed trucks as well as equipment on other vehicles as required.
- Performs and assists with the performance of daily inspections as required under BCTA Pre/Post Trip Inspection and completes equipment log books (WorkSafe BC) or any other regulatory requirements.
- Performs light maintenance and operating adjustments of assigned vehicles.
- Reports any mechanical deficiencies immediately to the immediate supervisor and garage for corrective action.
- Performs general housekeeping and cleaning of vehicles.
- Submits activity reports: timesheets, daily logs, purchase card records, work orders, etc.
- Attends safety meetings and various safety training courses as required.
- Attends other training as required for position.
- Assists work group performing duties related to the position as required.
- Picks up and delivers materials and equipment such as: sand, gravel, cement, lumber, steel, pipe, railings, barricades, compressors, pump, generators, etc.

- Flushes and cleans sewer lines, chambers, wetwells, water leaks, reservoirs, wastewater treatment plants, etc.
- Participates with work crews in all aspects of the day-to-day operations and maintenance of the regional water, wastewater and drainage systems as required.
- Provides relief for the Combo Truck Driver as required.

To be successful, you have:
