

THE TOWNSHIP OF ORO-MEDONTE REQUIRES A CROSSING GUARD - SHANTY BAY

The Township of Oro-Medonte is currently accepting applications for the position of **Crossing Guard at Shanty Bay Public School.**

Reporting to the Manager, Municipal Law Services the Crossing Guard will be responsible for providing safe access for children at the crosswalk, from 8:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. and again from 3:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, September to June.

The successful applicant will wear and use all safety equipment provided by the Township in order to maintain traffic control and to report motor vehicle carelessness to the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP), while maintaining control of the children(s) behaviour in an orderly fashion and reporting inappropriate behaviour to the school principal.

Candidates must be a minimum of 18 years of age, reliable, punctual and physically able to perform the duties required of the position, including but not limited to, standing and walking in a variety of weather conditions.

The successful candidate must be able to provide a Criminal Reference Check and Vulnerable Sector Check.

This position starts in early September and has a salary range of \$21.10 to \$26.26/hr. (2024 Salary Grid).
