The Township of Oro-Medonte is currently seeking applicants for the position of “**Equipment Operator**”. The applicant will report to the Operations Division of the Operations & Community Services Department.

The Equipment Operator is responsible for the following:

- The operation of trucks in excess of 1 ½ ton capacity with dump box, sander, and snowplow wing attachments;
- Operation of front-end loader, excavator, skid steer, pumper/water truck, tractor with blower attachment, 1-ton pickup truck with snowplow blade and sander/sander attachments, street sweeper, trailers and brush chipper;
- Review & follow up on work orders as directed;
- Emergency roadside tree removal, installation of barricades for road closures/detours;
- Performing light maintenance of equipment;
- Other duties as assigned.

The position of Equipment Operator is a physically strenuous position, which includes but is not limited to shoveling, raking, sweeping, bending, lifting, carrying and the use of heavy equipment and supplies.

The applicant must have completed grade 12 or equivalent combined with a minimum of two years related experience; have sound knowledge of maintenance and construction practices as well as being competent in operating construction equipment and large commercial motor vehicles. Experience with municipal road maintenance and construction would be an asset.

The successful candidate must be able to provide a satisfactory Criminal Reference Check to the Township and must hold and maintain a valid class DZ license with a satisfactory driving record inclusive of CVOR abstract and the ability to work well in a team setting. In addition, the successful candidate must be able to respond to emergency calls in a timely manner and will be required to work stand by and/or on call shifts; Must have the ability to work independently and is required to be available to work flexible hours including days, evenings, weekends and holidays as schedules and call-ins for emergency situations.
