The Operations Worker IV will supervise and participate in the work of a crew carrying out installation, rehabilitation, repair, inspection and testing of Water, Wastewater, and Storm Water systems. The successful candidate will coordinate and review work and ensure schedules and established performance standards are met. This position involves working in and around creeks/waterways and requires an understanding of environmental protocols and best management practices.

Requirements include Grade 12 or equivalent; EOCP Level I Certification for Wastewater Collection or Water Distribution; Traffic Control Certificate; three years of pipefitting experience in water or wastewater systems including experience in project management and experience and/or training directing the work of others; spill response training (as required); trained in confined space entry; considerable knowledge of field-based GIS software; BCWWA Certification in Cross Connection Control (as required); Certified in CCTV coding as required; and a valid Class 3 BC Driver's Licence with airbrake endorsement (as required) with an annual renewal of Driver's Abstract.
