Reporting to the Aquatic Supervisor, the Aquatic Programmer assists with the supervision, administration, implementation and delivery of aquatic programs and/or lifeguarding services.

Key Duties and Responsibilities

- Assists the Aquatics Supervisor with the supervision, administration and program development
 of aquatic programs and activities including learn to swim, schools, leadership and special needs
 programs, and evaluates same.
- Participates in staff and volunteer recruitment.
- Develops and implements staff training/orientation programs.
- Prepare staff schedule and review bi-weekly timesheets for accuracy and completion.
- Assist with marketing; registrations; program development and design.
- Responsible for identifying and monitoring established procedures to maintain Ministry of Health standards for quality and safety in and around the pool area.
- Statistics compilation and risk management.
- Liaise with participants/agencies and the general public in areas relating to aquatics.

Competencies and Qualifications

- Minimum of three years demonstrated experience preferably in a municipal aquatics/recreation environment in the development of aquatic or recreation programs.
- Diploma in Recreation and Leisure Services or related discipline.
- Valid National Lifeguard, LSS Swim, Lifesaving and Emergency First Aid Instructor, LSS Bronze Examiner, Aquatic Supervisor, Airway Management, SEE Auditor and Lifesaving Sport Coach Level 1.
- Advanced Aquatic Leadership certifications such as LSS Swim & Lifesaving Instructor Trainer, National Lifeguard Instructor/Examiner, LSS Standard First Aid Instructor/Examiner and Examiner Mentor.
- Excellent customer service, interpersonal, project/time management, analytical, and problem solving skills
- Ability to communicate effectively, professionally and courteously with all levels of staff, external
 contacts and the general public.
- Thorough working knowledge of pool operations and Ontario Health Act as it relates to aquatics.
- Ability to promote a culture of inclusiveness and work with a diverse population of employees and the general public.
- Experience with ActiveNet program/facility scheduling would be considered an asset
- Availability to work flexible hours as part of a regular schedule, including evenings and weekends.
- Able to submit a satisfactory Vulnerable Sector Check upon hire.
