The successful candidate will also co-administer the Road Usage Permitting program, review traffic plans for construction and public events, and lead community initiatives like Graffiti Management and Adopt-a-Road programs.

Ideal candidates have over 10 years of experience in Traffic Operations, expertise in municipal traffic systems and asset management, and preferably an IMSA Signs & Markings certification. This role requires a hands-on leader with strong communication skills to engage with the public, developers, and contractors in ensuring road safety and efficiency for the City of Kelowna.
