Responsibilities will include aiding the manager in implementing operational programs, addressing technical challenges, and handling safety and supervisory tasks to ensure the seamless day-to-day operations of this section.

Requirements include: completion of Grade 12 or equivalent; a two year diploma in related field; minimum of five years progressive experience in a Waterworks related position with a federal, provincial or municipal Public Works Department, or private contractor doing directly related work with similar responsibilities; experience in project management including planning, budgeting, cost estimating and scheduling; minimum of one year supervisory experience in a related operational area; Level III EOCP Certification in Water Distribution; Cross Connection Control Certification; extensive experience and completion of courses / training related to the hydraulics, construction and operation of water distribution system maintenance & SCADA systema operation and maintenance; possession of a valid Class 5 Driver's License and sufficient health and physical conditioning to permit performance of duties in all types of weather conditions. Candidates with an equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
