Reporting to the Manager of Transportation Infrastructure, the Team Lead, Transportation Development plays a key role in providing leadership to a team of dedicated transportation engineering professionals. Key duties include:

- Define terms of reference and perform detailed technical reviews of transportation impact studies.

- Experience leading transportation components of land development applications and developing and mentoring engineering technologists and/or Engineers-in-Training (EIT) are considered strong assets.
- Registered as a Professional Engineer (P.Eng) with the Engineering & Geoscientists of BC or out of province equivalent.
