Success in this role requires a background in community development or social services, a flair for social media, and a knack for planning engaging events. You'll be part of a collaborative team that comes together to ensure both our events, and our community thrive. Located on the Highway 2 corridor, the Town of Olds has a population of just under 10,000 people and is home to Olds College of Agriculture & Technology. Our community is fortunate to have robust leisure, cultural, and recreation amenities and a strong commercial and industrial sector, all of which make us the regional hub for approximately 35,000 people. This position is located at the Community Connection Center (CCC) in Uptowne Olds. The CCC links people in the community with social preventative services, programing, and information with the goals of promoting a high quality of life for citizens and building opportunities for everyone.

Typical Duties Include:

- Collaborating with community members and organizations to promote social development in Olds and the surrounding areas.
- Leading discussions to identify community needs and working with groups to develop and implement action plans.

- Offering insights on grant distribution, budget allocations, and policy enhancements to support social development.
