As the Revenue Supervisor, you are responsible for the collection of various payments made to the City, either billed by Financial Services or by other departments throughout the City. You oversee billing for all property and local area service taxes, waste collection, and water/sewer utility usage. You are the City's financial liaison with BC Transit and manage the local government partners' revenue collection and the City's payments for the annual operating agreement contract. Other areas of management and oversight include but are not limited to requirements of other taxing authority, property tax exemptions (permissive, revitalization and heritage), frontline customer service and property information support both internally with other departments and externally with property owners and other agencies.

Qualifications

Candidates should have their CPA designation with a minimum of five (5) years of relevant experience, preferably in local government finance. In-depth knowledge of and experience with accounting standards (PSAB, GAAP) is required. Familiarity with the Community Charter, Mobile Home Act, Assessment Act and other relevant statutes is an asset. The successful candidate will have excellent strategic thinking along with strong communication, teambuilding, and interpersonal skills to effectively supervise staff and build strong working relationships.
