### **Position Overview**

Reporting to the General Manager of Environmental Services or designate the Field Services Labourer position requires a self driven and motivated individual who is experienced in carpentry, water, wastewater, and building maintenance, and who can demonstrate excellent interpersonal and customer service skills.

### **Duties**

- Maintain and perform minor repairs and maintenance of PRRD infrastructure such as solid waste disposal equipment and site works, sewer system apparatus, recreation facilities and apparatus, other PRRD properties and buildings
- Ensure that vehicles, equipment, and buildings are maintained
- Snow and ice removal from PRRD properties
- Prepare reports of daily inspections, and provide oral and written reports to supervisory personnel
