The Website Developer II will be responsible for developing, implementing, maintaining, and supporting Software as a Service (SaaS) enterprise web applications for the City of Airdrie. This role will report to the Manager of Information Technology and work closely with the Technical Support Analyst. Additional development responsibilities may be assigned as needed to support internal systems development.

- Architect and develop database driven web-based applications and services using PHP, CodeIgniter and MSSQL/MySQL.
- Configure and maintain SaaS cloud hosted sites.
- Identify, troubleshoot and resolve web application issues.
- Build user interfaces based on user requirements and customer feedback that adhere to the WCAG standards for accessibility.
- Follow the web application development workflows for testing and migration of applications into production.
- Gather functional business requirements for current and future business needs.
- Document technical specifications and test plans.
- Develop automated error reports and notifications to alert staff of issues before customers call for support.
- Maintain and enhance development skills and knowledge to keep up with current website and application development trends.
- Develop secure web applications that adhere to OWASP standards and can withstand application penetration tests.
- Collaborate and build relationships with relevant stakeholders in the organization.
- Collaborate with business and team members.

- Minimum of 5 years of work experience in a web developer role providing web development and technical support to business units.
