Reporting to the Lead Mechanic, the Heavy Duty Mechanic is responsible for performing duties on all County on-road and off-road equipment, focusing on heavy duty equipment but may be assigned to work on non-heavy duty equipment, including mechanical repairs, inspection, diagnosis, and various maintenance components.

Functional Responsibilities:

The position is responsible for:

- Perform repairs and maintenance on all fleet equipment, focusing on heavy-duty machinery
- Conduct scheduled servicing including oil changes, lubrication, tune-ups, and inspections
- Diagnose and troubleshoot mechanical issues using computerized and manual testing equipment
- Perform road tests before and after repairs to ensure proper functionality and safety
- Repair or replace components such as fuel systems, brakes, suspension, engines, drivetrains, and electrical systems
- Maintain accurate maintenance records, work orders, and parts inventory; order parts as needed within approved limits
- Mentor apprentice technicians and oversee contracted repair services to ensure quality and efficiency
- Ensure all repairs and shop operations follow County policies, safety regulations, and Alberta OHS standards
- Assist the Lead Mechanic in managing shop operations and support emergency response efforts as required

Functional Requirements:

- Worksites include a high level of noise, dust, grease and/or mud, moving vehicles or machines, and temperatures vary from very hot to very cold
- Normal safety precautions are required including the wearing of PPE such as safety boots, high visibility vest, and hearing protection
- Requires some physical exertion such as periods of standing, walking over rough and uneven terrain and recurring bending, crouching, stooping, and reaching
